

# 2020 COMMERCIAL LEAGUE VETERANS MEMORIAL GOLF COURSE

We have listed below notes relating to Rules, Fees and General Information.

League will begin on Tuesday, April 28th and round robin play will conclude on Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>. Field Day for all league players will be on Tuesday, August 18th. Playoff for the top four teams will be on Tuesday, August 18th. Start time for each week will be 5:30 PM.

We ask that sponsors notify us of their Team Captains. It will be the responsibility of each Captain to ensure that every member of his team is aware of these facts. This will hopefully enable each days play to run smoothly and allow us all to enjoy the game of golf.

1. ANNUAL FEES. Sponsors fee = \$60.00 (All Sponsor fees will be used for final league payouts)

2. WEEKLY FEES Vets Annual Members = \$12.00 Competition Fee  
Non Members = \$24.00 Competition Fee and Green Fees

### 3. TEAMS.

Each team will consist of 4 players weekly.

Format will be Match (1 point) & Medal play (1 point) with combined net (1 team point).

A possible 2 ½ points per player is achievable.

Any team playing without a full team will automatically lose 1½ points per player missing. Opposing team players must shoot a net 35 or better to win the final point available.

NOTE: It is advisable that two subs should also be arranged as each team is responsible for the entry fee on a weekly basis.

### 4. PLAYERS

Each player must have posted two nine hole rounds to qualify for a handicap.

A player who has no handicap established will not be eligible to compete. They can play on the day to establish a handicap only.

Handicaps will be adjusted weekly and posted ready for the following weeks play. It is each player's responsibility to ensure that they are playing to their correct and current handicap.

Maximum handicaps for 2020 season are: Men: 16 for nine holes - Ladies: 20 for nine holes

### 5. HANDICAP ADJUSTMENTS.

0 – 9 handicap: a maximum of double bogey

10 & over handicap – each player can have as many triple bogeys as their handicap exceeds 9 (12 handicap can have 6 doubles and 3 triples).

Handicaps will be given according to adjusted score, a maximum of down 3 or up 1 stroke each week.

Because of the combination of Match and Medal play, plus handicap implications. All putts must be holed out  
Failure to do so will result in:

1. Disqualification for gross/net play for that round.
2. The player will post a maximum of bogey for the hole that is not completed (for handicap adjustment purposes).
